

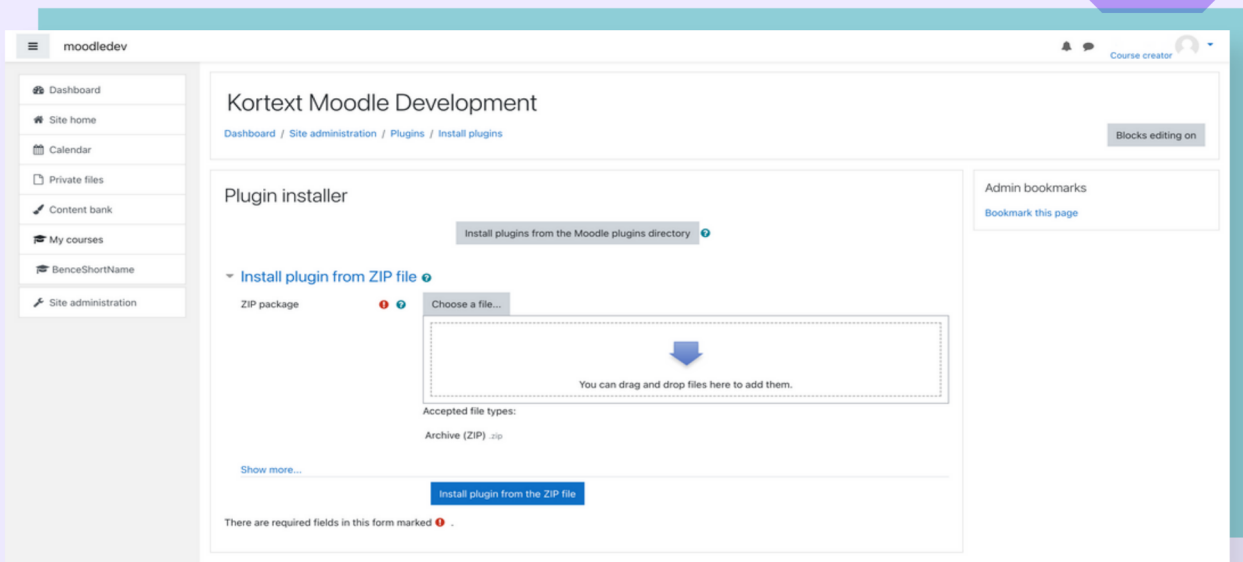
Integrating Kortex with Moodle

Kortex 

Installing the plug-in

To install the Kortext plug-in, you will need Moodle administration rights and the latest version of the Kortext plug-in.

1. Log in to Moodle as an Administrator.
2. Enter the Admin settings to install the plug-in. Choose the plug-in type and block before selecting the zip file and installing the plug-in. We recommend you back up your site or test the plug-in before you install it live.
3. Once installed, you can customise the block's settings.



Important key block options

Endpoint - Usually this should point to 'Production', but there may be a period when we ask you to use 'Test'.

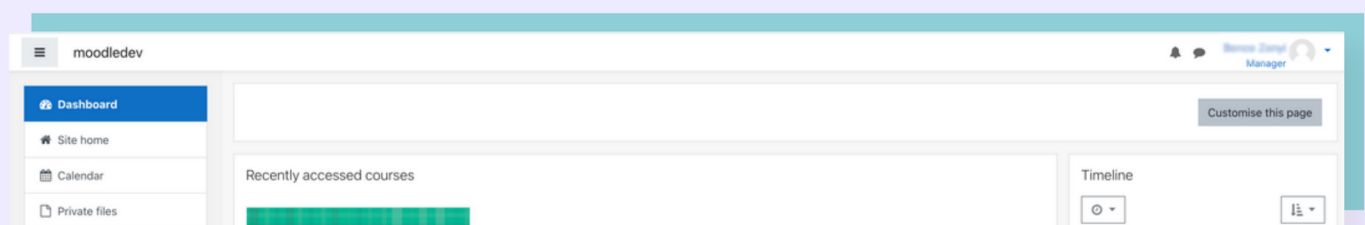
Lookup - This is a key option. If you have multiple books for each student, in different modules you may wish to use Module lookup. Please note that students are only shown books that are relevant for the module they are viewing.

Title - Whatever title you wish the block to show.

Customer and Secret Key - These will be provided to your institution on request. The Customer Key and Secret Key allow us to enable seamless access to the resources you have purchased for your students.

Other options include the size of the block, size of book covers displayed in the block and settings such as help email addresses.

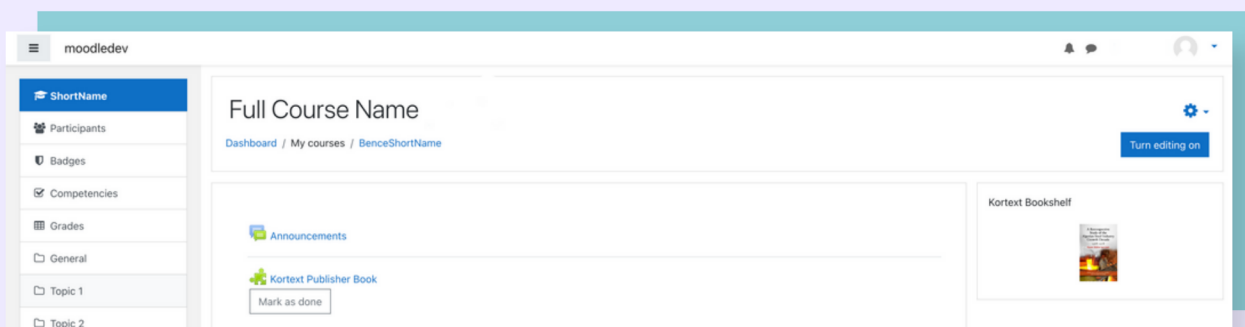
These can always be edited later. Once you have entered the details ensure you click on 'Save Changes'.



Adding the Kortext block to your courses

1. To add the Kortext block to your course you need to enter 'Edit' mode. To do this, select 'Turn Editing On'.
2. As you can now actively edit, select the 'Add Block' option and select either 'Kortext Bookshelf' or whatever you have named the block.
3. The Kortext block will then appear. You can, at this point, move the block where you want it on the screen and change any of the settings.
4. Once you are happy with the way the block is shown on screen, turn the editing mode off again and the changes will be saved.

Congratulations! Your Moodle block is now up and running.
